## I. ArmaXX Treatment Guidelines: Fleas

### Day of Services:

1. Have your dog or cat treated for fleas!!!!!!
2. Please remove all pets, including fish from your dwelling. (If this request is a problem, please contact ArmaXX for other options).
3. You will have to leave your home/property for a minimum of 2 hours.
4. All carpeted areas, upholstered furniture and cushions should be thoroughly vacuumed and the sweeper bag contents discarded in an outside container.
5. Blankets or rugs that may be used as pet bedding should be discarded or laundered in hot, soapy water.
6. Make sure all doors are unlocked, especially storage rooms, attics, basements, garage, etc.
7. Turn off heating/air conditioning units and fans.
8. Natural gas "pilot" lights need to be turned off.
9. If your home security system provides fire or carbon monoxide detection, please disable the device(s).
10. Collect all loose items found on the floor – i.e. pacifiers, bottles and small toys and secure. (Be sure to check corners, under beds, behind the couch, etc . . .)
11. Check under the bed for personal items and remove.

### Returning Home

1. Re-enter the home when the materials are completely dry - it may take 2- 4 hours to dry. Test for dryness by applying a paper towel on the floor and stepping on it. If no moisture is present, the area is safe to re-enter.
2. Open all doors.
3. Ventilate other rooms by opening windows, if applicable.
4. Do not vacuum for 24 hours.

## II. Maintenance Program

ArmaXX will need to re-treat your home for the next 3-6 weeks. Following our maintenance guidelines will increase the effectiveness of the service:

- Vacuum your home every two days for two weeks, especially around your baseboards. Why? Vacuuming helps to remove the eggs, larvae and pupae of fleas developing in homes.
- After vacuuming, throw the vacuum bag away in an outside container.

## III. FAQ

### Q1. Why do I need to treat my pets for fleas on the day of service?

A1. Since most flea problems originate from an infested cat or dog, elimination of fleas from the pets is the first and most important step. Talk to your veterinarian about the best treatment options.

### Q2. How long will I still see fleas?

A2. You will likely see fleas for up to 3 weeks. These fleas are newly hatched and were not removed from vacuuming. Once exposed to the residual materials, the new fleas will die.
